Notification

New Delhi, the _____, 2018

G.S.R. _____ (E).— In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section(1) read with clause (b) of sub-section (2) of section 156 of the Indo-Tibetan Border Police Force Act, 1992 (35 of 1992), the Central Government hereby makes the following rules to amend the Indo-Tibetan Border Police Force, General Duty Group 'A' posts Recruitment Rules, 2018 namely:-

1. Short title and commencement .----(1) These rules may be called the Indo-Tibetan Border Police Force, General Duty Cadre Group 'A' Posts Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2018.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Schedule to the Indo-Tibetan Border Police Force, General Duty Cadre Group "A" posts Recruitment Rules, 2018,-

(a) Against serial number 3, relating to the post of Commandant(General Duty), in column 10, for the existing entries, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

" By promotion failing which deputation from other CAPF or from IPS"

By Promotion:

From amongst Second-in-Command(General Duty) of the Indo-Tibetan Border Police Force in level 12 of the pay matrix with five years of regular service in the grade with total fifteen years of regular service in Group A and having successfully completed the prescribed pre-promotional training course.

Note: Where juniors who have completed their qualifying or eligibility service are being considered for promotion their seniors would also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying or eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying or eligibility service or two years, whichever is less, and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher level in the pay matrix alongwith their juniors who have already completed such qualifying or eligibility service.

Deputation:

- (i) Officers of the rank of Commandant(General Duty) from Central Armed Police Forces.
- (ii) Indian Police Service Officers holding equivalent posts or holding the post of Superintendent of Police.

(b) Against serial number 4, relating to the post of Second in Command(General Duty), in column 10, for the existing entries, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

“ By promotion failing which deputation from other CAPF or from IPS”

By Promotion:

From amongst Deputy Commandants(General Duty) of the Indo-Tibetan Border Police Force in level 11 in the pay matrix with five years regular service in the grade and total ten years of regular service in Group 'A' and having successfully completed the prescribed pre-promotional training course.

Note: Where juniors who have completed their qualifying or eligibility service are being considered for promotion their seniors would also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying or eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying or eligibility service or two years, whichever is less, and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher level in the pay matrix alongwith their juniors who have already completed such qualifying or eligibility service.

Deputation:

- (i) Officers of the rank of Second in Commandant(General Duty) from Central Armed Police Forces.
- (ii) Indian Police Service Officers holding equivalent posts or holding the post of Additional Superintendent of Police.
