


- j) Those Bidders not registered on the website mentioned above, are required to get registered beforehand. If needed they can be imparted training on online bidding process as per details available on the website.
- k) The intending bidder must have valid class-III digital signature to submit the bid.
- l) On opening date of Financial Bid, the Bidder can login and see the bid opening process. After opening of financial bids, he will receive the competitor's bid sheets.
- m) Bidder can upload documents in the form of JPG format and PDF format.
- n) The Department reserves the right to reject any prospective application without assigning any reason.

2) List of mandatory Documents to be scanned and uploaded within the period of bid submission:-

- (a) Proprietor or one of the partners or one of the Directors of the firm/consultant must be Architects (Minimum Qualification Bachelor of Architecture at least with 7 Years' Experience) or structural engineer (Minimum Qualification M. Tech. at least with 7 Years' Experience) with valid registration from Council of Architecture and Institute of Engineers (India) respectively.
- (b) Average annual financial turnover on Architectural/Engineering consultancy works during the last three years ending 31st March of the financial year 2023-24 should be at least (not less than 10% of estimated Cost of this work) verified from CA (Format as per CIWD SOP-2022/P-202 (Form-A). To bring up to the current year the turnover shall be calculated with 7% compounding each year. (Page No. 32 of tender form)
- (c) Consultancy fee received from Architectural/Engineering Consultancy work from a single project during last 7 years ending 31st March of the previous financial year i.e. 2023-24 should be at least 80% of the estimated cost, two projects each of at least 60% of the estimated cost and three projects each of at least 40% of the estimated cost for consultancy services of present work. (Documentary evidence as needs to be submitted). To bring up to the current year cost shall be calculated with 7% compounding each year. (Form 'E' Page No. 37 of Tender form)
- (d) Agency must have successfully completed the consultancy work for a RCC buildings with Electrical, Water supply, Sanitary, HVAC, Firefighting etc. all complete work of a RCC Permanent buildings within seven years of any Central/State Government Deptt./Central Public sector/State Public sector Undertaking/Central Autonomous body / State Autonomous body/City Development authority/ Municipal Corporation of city formed under any act by central/State Government and published in Central/State gazette/listed public/private/Pvt limited company. (Documentary evidence needs to be submitted for verification with address, phone no, e mail id of competent authority of Deptt / owner of building.)
- (e) Copy of Pan Card.
- (f) Copy of GST registration. (If the bidder has not obtained GST registration in the State in which the work is to be taken up, or as required by GST authorities then in such a case the bidder shall scan and upload following Affidavit along with other bid documents.

If work is awarded to me, I/we shall obtain GST registration Certificate of the State in which work is to be taken up, within one month from the date of receipt of award letter or before release of any payment by Deptt, whichever is earlier, failing which I/We shall be responsible




3. The tender can only be submitted after uploading the mandatory scanned documents as per list given below.

1. The Firms/Consultants should have completed the following Criteria.
 - a) Proprietor or one of the partners or one of the Directors of the firm/consultant must be Architects (Minimum Qualification Bachelor of Architecture at least with 7 Years' Experience) or structural engineer (Minimum Qualification M. Tech at least with 7 Years' Experience) with valid registration from Council of Architecture and Institute of Engineers (India) respectively.
 - b) Average annual financial turnover on Architectural/Engineering consultancy works during the last Three years, ending 31st March of the financial year 2023-24 should be at least 10% of estimated Cost of this work) verified from CA (Format as per CPWD SOP-2022/P-202 (Form-A). To bring up to the current year the turnover shall be calculated with 7% compounding each year. (Page No 32 of tender form)
 - c) Consultancy fee received from Architectural/Engineering Consultancy work from a single project during last seven years, ending 31st March of the previous financial year i.e. 2023-24, should be at least 80% of the estimated cost, two projects each should be at least 60% of the estimated cost and three projects each should be at least 40% of the estimated cost for consultancy services of present work. (Documentary evidence needs to be submitted). To bring up to the current year cost shall be calculated with 7% compounding each year. (Form "E" Page No. 37 of Tender form)
 - d) Agency must have successfully completed the consultancy work for a RCC buildings with Electrical, Water supply, Sanitary, HVAC, firefighting etc. all complete work of a RCC Permanent buildings within seven years of any Central/ State Government (Dept./ Central Public sector/ State Public sector

Undertaking/ Central Autonomous body / State Autonomous body/ City Development authority/ Municipal Corporation of city formed under any act by central/State Government and published in Central/State gazette/ listed public/ private limited company (Documentary evidence needs to be submitted).
- e) Earnest Money of Rs. 22700/- only in form of Banker cheque/CDR/ bank draft/ Fixed Deposit receipt from commercial bank drawn in favour of The Deputy Inspector General, SHQ (SNR), ITBP, Zewan Camp, Panthachowk, Srinagar (J&K). Receipt of the EMD shall be scanned and uploaded to the e-tendering website within the period of bid submission.
- f) The consultant can deposit original EMD either in the office of Dy. Commandant (Engg) SHQ (SNR) inviting bids or in any unit/formation of ITBP within the period of bid submission. The consultant shall obtain the receipt of EMD from the concerned unit/formation in the prescribed format. (Page No. 21 of tender form) The Bid Document as uploaded can be viewed and downloaded free of Cost by anyone including intending bidder. But the bid can only become valid after uploading the mandatory scanned copy of EMD in favour of The Deputy Inspector General, SHQ (SNR), ITBP, Zewan Camp, Panthachowk, Srinagar (J&K) along with copy of receipt of original EMD and other documents specified.
- g) The intending Bidder must read the terms and conditions of NIT carefully. He should only submit his bid if he considers himself eligible and he is in possession of all the documents required.
- h) Information and instructions for bidders posted on website shall form part of bid documents.
- i) The bid document consisting of scope of work, terms and conditions of the contract to be completed

(g) Scanned Copy of EMD (in form of Banker cheque/CDR/ bank draft/ Fixed Deposit receipt from commercial bank) along with receipt of original EMD deposited in any formations of ITBP. (Page No. 21 of tender form)
