Notice Inviting e-Tender

The Deputy Commandant (Engr), Sector Head Quarters (Almora) ITBP on behalf of the President of India invites online Percentage Rate tender from approved and eligible firms/contractors of CPWD, MES, Railway, BRO, Telecom, State PWD and BSNL registered under Building construction category in appropriate class and similar work and registered Pre Engineered Building manufacturing firms in Central or State Govt are also invited having work experience and capacity to do PEB work including civil and electrical work and provide consultancy services from reputed consultant Agency Firm for the following work :-

1. The enlistment of the contractors should be valid on the last date of submission of tenders. In case, the last date of submission of tender is extended, the enlistment of contractor should be valid on the original date of submission of tenders.
2. The intending bidder must read the terms and conditions of **Tender form** carefully. He should only submit his bid if he considers himself eligible and he is in possession of all the documents required.
3. Information and Instructions for bidders posted on website shall form part of bid document.
4. The bid document consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents can be seen and downloaded from website www.eprocure.gov.in & www.itbp.gov.in.
5. The tender can only be submitted after uploading the mandatory scanned documents as per list given below.
 - I. Copy of valid enlistment certificate (Eligible class)
 - II. Copy of GST registration.
 - III. Tender form duly signed.
 - IV. Work experience certificate.
 - V. List of work completed as per tender document
 - VI. PAN card
 - VII. Income Tax Return Last three years duly signed
 - VIII. Certificate of financial turnover duly audited by CA (must have average annual financial turnover of at least 30% of the estimated cost put to tender during the immediate last five consecutive financial years for meeting the eligibility criterion).
 - IX. EPF & ESI.
 - X. Solvency Certificate of min amount equal to 40% of the estimated cost put to tender.

6. Those contractors not registered on the website mentioned above, are required to get registered beforehand. If needed, they can be imparted training on online bidding process as per details available on the website.
7. The intending bidder must have valid class-III digital signature to submit online bid.
8. Bidder should not have past track record of delaying works.
9. On opening date, the contractor can login and see the bid opening process. After opening of bids he will receive the competitor bid sheets.
10. Contractor can upload documents in the form of JPG format and PDF format.
11. Contractor must ensure to quote rate of each item, if any cell is left blank and no rate is quoted by the tenderer, rate of such item shall be treated as "0" (ZERO). However, if tenderer quotes Nil rates against each item in item rate tender or does not quote any percentage above/below on the lowest amount of the tender or any section/sub head in percentage rate tenders, the tender shall be treated as invalid and will not be considered as lowest tender.
12. The required documents meeting the criteria to qualify as "approved and eligible" contractors of CPWD, MES, Railway, State PWD & Telecom/BSNL Deptt. registered under Building construction category in appropriate class and similar work and registered Pre Engineered Building manufacturing firms in Central or State Govt are also invited having work experience and capacity to do PEB work including civil and electrical work and provide consultancy services from reputed consultant Agency Firm etc along with other documents as mentioned under Para "List of Documents to be scanned and uploaded by the agency and hard copies received subsequently" shall be checked first, while opening the bid. The financial bid of only those agencies shall be opened who are found to be eligible agencies, as per this NIT.
13. For Consultancy part Proprietor or one of the partners or one of the Director of the firm/consultant must be Architects (Minimum Qualification Bachelor of Architecture at least with 5 Years Experience) or structural engineer (Minimum Qualification M. Tech at least with 5 Years Experience) with valid registration from Council of Architecture and Institute of Engineers (India) respectively.
14. Average Annual Financial Turnover on part of Architectural/ Engineering Consultancy works during the last three years, ending 31st March of the previous financial year i.e. 2023-24 should be at least 25.00 Lakh. (Documentary evidence needs to be submitted).
15. Consultancy fee received from Architectural/ Engineering Consultancy work from a single project during last three years, ending 31st March of the previous financial year i.e. 2023-24 should be at least 35.00 lakh. (Documentary evidence is needs to be submitted). To bring up to the current year the turnover shall be calculated with 7% compounding each year.
16. Agency must have successfully completed the consultancy work for a RCC buildings with Electrical, Water supply, Sanitary, HVAC, Fire fighting etc. all complete work of a RCC Permanent buildings at least 5 lakh (Five lakh) within three years of any Central/ State Government Deptt./ Central Public sector/ State Public sector Undertaking/Central Autonomous body / State Autonomous body/City Development authority/ Municipal Corporation of city formed under any act by central/State Government and published in Central/State gazette/listed public/private limited company. To bring up to the current year the turnover shall be calculated with 7% compounding each year. (Documentary evidence is needs to be submitted).
17. The department reserves the right to reject any prospective application without assigning any reason and to restrict the list of qualified contractors to any number deemed suitable by it, if too many bids are received satisfying the laid down criterion.
