G.S.R. _____(E).- In exercise of the powers conferred by clause(b) of sub section(2) of section 156 of the Indo-Tibetan Border Police Force Act, 1992 (35 of 1992), the Central Government hereby makes the following rules to amend the Assistant Commandant (Office) and Assistant Commandant (Staff Officer), Group 'A' posts Recruitment Rules, 2010 namely :-

1. Short title and commencement.— (I) These rules may be called the Indo-Tibetan Border Police Force, Assistant Commandant (Office) and Assistant Commandant (Staff Officer), Group 'A' posts Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2021.

(II) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Schedule to the Indo-Tibetan Border Police Force, Assistant Commandant (Office) and Assistant Commandant (Staff Officer), Group "A" posts Recruitment Rules, 2010,-

(a) Against Rule no 8, relating to the age of superannuation, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

Officers holding the post of Assistant Commandant (Office) and Assistant Commandant (Staff Officer) shall retire from the service on the afternoon of the last day of the month in which they attain the age of sixty years.

Provided that an officer whose date of birth is on the first day of a month shall retire from service on the afternoon of the last day of the preceding month on attaining the age of sixty years.

(b) Against serial number 1, relating to the post of Assistant Commandant (Office)-

(i) In column 2, for the entries, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

"41" (2021)

* Subject to variation dependent on workload."

(ii) In column 11, for the entries, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

100% by Promotion

(iii) In column 12, for the entries, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

By Promotion :

From amongst Inspector (Combatant Ministerial) of Indo-Tibetan Border Police Force in Level-7 with three years regular service in the grade and have successfully completed the 2-4 weeks pre-promotional course/training as prescribed.

Note 1 – Where juniors who have completed their qualifying or eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their senior would also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying or eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying or eligibility service or two years, whichever is less, and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher grade alongwith their juniors who have already completed such qualifying or eligibility service.

(c) Against serial number 2, relating to the post of Assistant Commandant (Staff Officer)-

(i) In column 2, for the entries, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

"26" (2021)

* Subject to variation dependent on work load."

(ii) In column 11, for the entries, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

100% by Promotion

(iii) In column 12, for the entries, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

By Promotion :

From amongst Inspector (Stenographers) of Indo-Tibetan Border Police Force in Level-7 with three years regular service in the grade and have successfully completed the 2-4 weeks pre-promotional course/training as prescribed.

Note 1 – Where juniors who have completed their qualifying or eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their senior would also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying or eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying or eligibility service or two years, whichever is less, and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher grade alongwith their juniors who have already completed such qualifying or eligibility service.
